Come along to view a selection of panels from the beautiful Scottish Diaspora Tapestry.

Scots have migrated all over the world and have often had a profound impact on the areas where they settled. This project will see 25 such communities documenting their Scottish connections on a series of embroidered panels. Their combined stories will pay homage to the incredible determination and courage of Scots over the centuries.

The Scottish Diaspora Tapestry is an inspiringly ambitious community arts project organised by Prestoungrange Arts Festival, the team behind the famous *Prestonpans Tapestry.* Since 2012 they have been contacting communities with Scottish roots right across the world, offering an irresistible invitation: why not tell Scotland *your* story!

Since then a vast team of international volunteers has been busy researching, reporting, and stitching their links to Scotland. No other visual arts project has ever attempted to connect the Scottish Diaspora in this way!
